**GIVE BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF WHAT HAPPENED:**

On January 12, 2008 the complainant reported to the Metropolitan Police Department First District that she was a victim of an assault. The affiant interviewed the complainant. The complainant explained that she and the suspect had been drinking alcoholic beverages at the restaurant. The complainant decided to go with the suspect to his apartment to watch television and hang out. The complainant and the suspect became involved in a verbal dispute about the different telephone numbers inside of her cellular phone. The suspect became angry with the complainant and threw the cable box into the glass table smashing it into pieces. The complainant told the suspect that she wanted to leave. The suspect snapped and refused to allow the complainant to leave his home. The complainant was forced to remain inside of the suspect's apartment for a hour and a half. The complainant attempted to leave the suspect's home by walking out of the door. A fight ensued between the complainant and the suspect. The suspect grabbed the complainant and pushed her onto the floor. The complainant screamed out loud and the suspect covered her mouth with his hand. The suspect pushed the complainant onto the bed and held her down. The complainant tried to call the police but the suspect grabbed her blackberry cellular phone and broke it. The suspect grabbed a knife from the night stand and stabbed her in the left hand. The complainant described the weapon as a utility knife which is attached to a cork screw and a can opener. The complainant believes that the suspect uttered the words to her, "Do you want to get serious?" At that point, the suspect grabbed an unknown object and placed it underneath the left part of her neck. The suspect asked the complainant, "Do you want to die?" The complainant replies and she stated, "No, I don't want to die." The suspect calms down and tells the complainant that she could leave. The complainant was told to wash the blood from her hand and she had to promise the suspect that she would not call the police. The complainant left the suspect's home and walked to the house of her co-worker. The police was notified to respond to 620 3<sup>rd</sup> Street NE. The complainant received a laceration to her chin and cuts to the left hand. The complainant was transported to George Washington Hospital by Ambulance# 18. The complainant was treated by Dr. Roche of the Emergency Room staff and released. The complainant received eight stitches in her chin.

On January 25, 2008 the complainant responded to the First District station and gave the affiant a photograph of the suspect. The complainant positively identified the suspect as Brent Damien Furer, White, Male and Date of Birth of September 12, 1968. The suspect is a resident at 333 7<sup>th</sup> Street NE. The complainant has known the suspect for a year. The complainant and the suspect were involved in a romantic relationship with each other for five months. The suspect is the complainant's ex-boyfriend.

All of these described events took place within the District of Columbia. Therefore based upon the aforementioned facts and circumstances, the below affiant believes that probable cause exists and respectfully requests that an arrest warrant be issued for the suspect, BRENT DAMIEN FURER.
