- 1. (U) SITUATION. Change.
 - 1.A. (U) AQI and Extremists are using official GoI vehicles (ambulances, police vehicles, ministry vehicles and contract PSD vehicles) to transport weapons and contraband, and to generally support illegal activity.
 - 1.B. (U) The Baghdad Operations Center (BOC), in cooperation and coordination with MND-B, will open weekly combined temporary checkpoints (TCPs) within the Baghdad Security Districts expressly targeting Iraqi vehicular traffic in order to accomplish three primary objectives: 1) to undermine the movement of terrorists and armed militias benefiting from government vehicles or official convoys; 2) to prevent illicit material trafficking; and 3) to reduce corruption within the Iraqi government. These checkpoints will be jointly manned and executed by CF and ISF.
 - 1.C. (U) This FRAGO establishes procedures for CF Convoys, Personal Security Details (PSDs), Private Security Companies (PSCs), and low profile CF/USG personnel to use when encountering these TCPs. These procedures can also be used by Third Country National (TCN) Diplomatic Missions, as well as by Gol Tier 1 PSD Convoys. PSCs engaged in commercial activities that are not contracted by the U.S. Government, Coalition Forces, or TCN Diplomatic Missions, as well as Gol Tier
