Dear Dr. Allawi:

We are delighted that you have agreed to retain Barbour Griffith & Rogers, LLC. We have prepared the following contract for your review and approval which memorializes our earlier conversations and correspondence.

**Scope of Work:** BGR will provide strategic counsel and representation for and on behalf of Dr. Ayad Allawi before the U.S. Government, Congress, media and others.

**BGR Team:** All resources of BGR would be available to Dr. Allawi and his moderate Iraqi colleagues as we undertake this work. However, BGR will designate a core team of professionals who will be dedicated to this project. I will lead the team and will draw upon the considerable experience of my colleague, BGR Chairman Ed Rogers. In addition, our core team will be supplemented by Dr. Andrew Parasiliti and Mr. Walker Roberts.

**Fees and Expenses:** In consideration of our services, BGR would be paid a monthly fee of US\$50,000.00 in quarterly installments of \$150,000.00, beginning on August 1, 2007 for the first quarterly period from August-October, and in advance of each subsequent quarter, continuing through January 31, 2008.

Additionally, BGR would be reimbursed for ordinary and out-of-pocket expenses, including items such as telecommunications services, printing, copying, local transportation and other incidental expenses. BGR would also be reimbursed for non-local transportation, meals, and entertainment; however, these would be authorized by Dr. Allawi in advance.

**Invoicing:** Professional fees and expenses are invoiced separately:

**1. Professional Fees:** BGR will invoice Dr. Allawi US\$150,000.00 on the first day of each three-month quarterly period in advance of the following coming quarter, beginning on August 1, 2007.

**2. Expenses:** BGR will invoice Dr. Allawi on the last day of each month for expenses incurred during the month prior, starting on August 31, 2007.

All payments for fees and expenses will be paid via wire from Dr. Allawi to BGR. Regardless of the ultimate duration of the Agreement, all invoices generated from the terms and between the two parties to this agreement are payable in-full and promptly upon receipt and shall be paid directly to BGR.

**Renewal & Extension:** This contract may be reviewed on or before January 31, 2008, and may be extended upon agreement by both parties.

**Termination:** Either BGR or Dr. Allawi will be able to terminate this Agreement for any reason upon sixty (60) days written notice, without further obligation, other than to pay such fees and expenses that have accrued up to and through the notice period.


