On 5/13/14 at 1145 hours, Ofc. Ruby #5653 responded to WMAR-TV located at 6400 York Rd. in reference to a disturbance. Dispatch advised that there was a black male subject, approximately 20-30 years old, wearing a light blue button-up shirt and blue jeans yelling and cursing outside of the above listed office building. As responding units neared the location, added information to the call revealed that the Suspect was actively ramming the front doors of the building with a "dark green truck".

The first unit on scene advised that a large dark green truck had driven through the front doors of the building and was stopped in the lobby. Additional units responded and were told by fleeing WMAR-TV associates that the Suspect, once inside of the building, grabbed a fire extinguisher and sprayed it into the air. The Suspect then ran up the steps of the lobby and onto the second floor carrying a 'rigid" black bag. Responding units proceeded to the second floor of the location and waited for additional support units to arrive.

The building was evacuated and a perimeter was set up around the exterior of the location, York Rd. was closed off and bus routes were re-routed as

specialized support units arrived on scene, including Baltimore County Police Aviation, K-9, HNT, Baltimore County Tactical Units, Baltimore City Tactical Units, and Command personnel. One employee of WMAR-TV had sheltered in the basement of the office building and was escorted from the building by tactical units in an Armored personnel carrier,

As the incident unfolded, the occupants of the office lobby during the initial breach of the front doors were identified and interviewed by Det. Bialecki #4803 and Det. Bracken #3628.

Interviewee Bruce Henn, the Building Supervisor for WMAR-TV, advised he was in the office lobby when a "slim black male" wearing a blue shirt and blue jeans attempted to enter the locked glass doors. When he was denied entry, Interviewee Henn stated the subject became angry and attempted to "rip the door open". Interviewee Henn advised when the subject could not gain entry, he retreated to a landscaping truck and drove up the "entrance steps". Interviewee Henn advised after striking the front glass vestibule of the building several times, the truck eventually broke through the vestibule and entered the lobby of the

building, forcing Interviewee Henn to take cover behind a nearby wall.

Interviewee Henn stated once inside of the lobby, the subject got out of the truck with a fire extinguisher and discharged it over the "front of the truck and into the air". Interviewee Henn advised at this point he lost eye contact with the subject and retreated into a nearby office.

Detectives then spoke with Interviewee Paul Wilkinson, the Director of Engineering for WMAR-TV. Interviewee Wilkinson advised he was in his office on the second floor when he heard a loud voice yelling from the area of the front vestibule of the building. When he proceeded to the lobby, Interviewee Wilkinson advised he observed Interviewee Henn standing at the front door with a "medium build, African American male, mid to late 30's, dark pants, blue shirt yelling and trying to pull the double doors open, yelling Let me in". After several minutes, Interviewee Wilkinson advised the subject stated "If you aren't going to let me in, I have something for you". Interviewee Wilkinson advised the subject then turned and left, carrying a black pack slung over his shoulder that seemed "rigid". Interviewee Wilkinson advised at this time he thought the subject was leaving, but he then returned in a large truck and struck the outer doors of the vestibule.

On the next attempt, Interviewee Wilkinson stated the truck broke through the vestibule, "shattering all of the glass". On the next few attempts, the truck entered the lobby completely. Interviewee Wilkinson advised once the vehicle had entered the lobby he had to jump to his right behind a nearby wall to avoid being struck by the vehicle.

Detectives then spoke with Interviewee Anita Wilson, a security guard for WMAR-TV. Interviewee Wilson advised she was working at the front desk of the building when a subject attempted to enter through the locked doors of the vestibule and stated he wanted to go inside. Interviewee Wilson advised after several moments, the subject then began pulling harder on the doors and yelling. Interviewee Wilson advised at this time she called for Police assistance. The subject began to walk away and Interviewee Wilson stated she believed the subject was leaving, but he returned in a large truck and drove up the walkway, ramming into the front vestibule. After several more instances of striking the vestibule, the truck entered the lobby, first driving towards the security desk where she was standing, approximately 8 feet from the initial impact with the

front vestibule. As the vehicle entered the lobby, Interviewee Wilson was forced to take cover in a nearby office.

A search through MVA of the truck registration, MD/86L364 revealed that the vehicle was registered to Greenskeeper Environmental LLC with an address listed as 17701 New Hampshire Ave. 20861. As Baltimore County Police personnel held the perimeter around the building and additional units arrived, it was revealed that the vehicle had just been reported stolen from the area of I695 and York Rd. (ref CC# 14-133-0947). A search of the interior of the vehicle revealed an empty box that had at one point contained a machete.

Baltimore County Tactical and K-9 units made entry into the building and began clearing the interior rooms and offices. After a thorough search of the building it was determined that the Suspect had barricaded himself in an office on the second floor of the location. A video feed obtained from inside of the locked room showed the Suspect sitting and watching news coverage of the incident. The video feed also revealed the Suspect had a large black bag on the floor next to him.

At approximately 1630 hours, Tactical units breached the locked room and the Suspect was located and arrested. Search incident to arrest revealed a Maryland driver's license with the Suspect's picture. The Suspect was identified as Defendant Vladimir Mehul Baptiste (B/M/ 11/23/85) with an address of 1722 White Oak Rd. 21234. The Defendant was also placed into custody wearing a light blue button-up shirt and blue jeans, as described by witnesses.

Located in the room were several pieces of paper that the Defendant had taped onto the windows facing Police personnel and media outside. The papers read as follows:

"I am God almighty!"

"I gave you everything you never earned it"

"Fuck your multiverses! You have created to hurt my people!"

"I'm here to save you all from the energies"

"You are in the wrong timeline"

Located in the Defendant's black bag were several miscellaneous documents with the Defendant's name on them as well as a black Casio G'Zone cell phone. Det. Bialecki later received a phone call from Victim David Laishley who advised his black Casio cell phone was missing from his office at WMAR-TV. Further investigation revealed that Victim Laishley's office was the room that Defendant Baptiste had barricaded himself in. Victim Laishley confirmed the phone number and passcode to gain entry into the phone.

Ofc. Ruby reviewed the security footage from the front lobby of the building and observed the subject positively identified as Defendant Baptiste, driving the large green truck through the glass vestibule and into the lobby of the building, first directing the vehicle towards the front security desk. The video shows the Defendant then reversing and again driving towards the center of the lobby,

reversing and driving towards the stairs in the center of the lobby, then finally reversing and driving to the right of the lobby, with the vehicle coming to rest approximately 22 ft. from the initial impact with the glass vestibule.

Defendant Baptiste was transported to GBMC for minor injuries and an emergency evaluation was conducted by Dr. Bunkley. At 1100 hours, Defendant Baptiste was discharged from GBMC and transported to Precinct06/Towson for processing per departmental procedures.

At Precinct06/Towson, Defendant Baptiste was read his rights per Miranda and advised he understood them and voluntarily waived his rights. Det. Bialecki and Ofc. Ruby interviewed Defendant Baptiste.

Defendant Baptiste stated he is a reincarnation of "King Tut" and "Jesus Christ" and lives in a world of "multiverses" where bad things happen to people and they disappear because they are not real. Defendant Baptiste stated the "Malaysian Flight 370" and the "kidnapping of the Nigerian Schoolgirls" were examples of the multiverses in that they never actually happened.



Defendant Baptiste stated on the morning of 5/13/14, he woke up and decided he was going to "expose the multiverse world" and walked from his residence of 1722 White Oak Rd. to the area of 1695 and York Rd. Defendant Baptiste stated he saw the large green truck belonging to Greenskeeper Environmental LLC unoccupied with the keys in the ignition. Defendant Baptiste stated he got in the truck and drove down York Rd. towards the area of WMAR-TV. As he neared WMAR-TV, Defendant Baptiste stated he saw an opportunity to "expose the multiverses" and stated by smashing the truck into WMAR-TV he could "close the multiverse" that WMAR-TV represented. Defendant Baptiste stated he drove the truck into the front of the building and sprayed the fire extinguisher.

Defendant Baptiste stated he made his way to Victim Laishley's office and began watching television of the incident because he was "waiting for the multiverse to close". When asked about Victim Laishley's black Casio phone, Defendant Baptiste stated he put it into his bag because "the phone didn't belong to anyone, it's not real because it's in a multiverse". Defendant Baptiste agreed to complete a written statement.
